



FOOD VENDING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

To participate, you must agree, adhere to and initial each of the following Terms:

1. Placement of truck/cart of mobile stand will be directed by PVDfest staff and may change as necessary. **Under no circumstances may Vendors change or move locations.**
2. Vendors are required to open by event start time and exit the premises no later than one hour after event ends or as instructed by the PVDfest Vendor Coordinator.
3. Vendors will receive PVDfest identification badges in advance of the festival. Badges must be worn at all times.
4. Vendors may only set up and vend in area assigned to them.
5. Vendors must have all necessary and current licenses available for viewing at the time of vending.
6. Food vendors must post prices in a legible manner and in a visible space inside the booth.
7. The sale of and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages of any kind outside of approved areas is strictly prohibited.
8. Vendors must provide trash receptacles for waste generated by their booth and remove all operational waste from the premises upon departure. In addition, the ZERO WASTE GUIDE provided with the application MUST be adhered to. **IMPROPER TRASH DISPOSAL IS GROUNDS FOR EXCLUSION FROM PARTICIPATION IN FUTURE EVENTS AND SUBJECT TO A LITTERING FINE.**
9. No electricity is provided and none shall be used. We ask that vendors who use generators use the quietest model available.
10. All Vendors' booths, signage, and banners must have a professional look and presentation.
11. Vendors, if accepted, will be notified by February 15, 2019. Payment is due within two weeks of acceptance notification.
12. Vendors must have liability insurance of at least One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00), naming FirstWorks and the City of Providence, as additional insured's. This is ONLY required from vendors who are accepted and proof of insurance must accompany payment within two weeks of acceptance notification.
